

LAMBERT-ST. LOUIS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

STRIKE AND PICKET PROCEDURES

1. Pickets will be permitted at the Airport only when the company or tenant involved has an operation or business established, or written permission is obtained from the Director of Airports.
2. Demonstrators or pickets will not be permitted in any hangar, office, or area on the field side of the Terminal Building.
3. Persons other than pickets may not enter any building if they have any identification displayed indicating that they are demonstrators or sympathizers.
4. At no time will pickets walk in such a manner as to restrict or block movement of employees, the public, or vehicles.
5. Pickets will conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times.
6. The Director of Airports, or his appointed representative, shall approve the number of pickets permitted at any one location and, at his discretion, may change locations, increase or decrease the allowed number of pickets at any location, or rescind any such permission he may have previously granted.
7. Pickets will be permitted to picket 20 feet in front of the counter or building of the company involved. They shall not go beyond the limits of the counter or building of that company.
8. No signs may be posted or affixed to Airport property. No circulars may be distributed unless by express written approval of the Director of Airports and under such conditions as he may prescribe.
9. Failure to comply with any of these rules will be cause to remove all pickets.
10. No congregating in or about the picket area.
11. All vehicles must be parked in an authorized area.
12. No eating and/or drinking (either soft or intoxicating) beverages will be allowed on the picket line.
13. Pickets will not be permitted to stop and converse with pedestrians and/or vehicles for any purpose whatsoever.
14. The individual responsible for the picket line must give his name and telephone number to the Airport Police, as well as that of the Union Representative. This information must be given to the Airport Police prior to the establishment of the picket line.
15. Any disputes pertaining to these Rules and Regulations shall be referred to Airport Police at STA. 2100, or 426-8100.
