United Airlines to Launch St. Louis – San Francisco Service

Daily nonstop service begins early 2010

CHICAGO, Oct. 22, 2009 – United Airlines today announced the airline will launch daily nonstop service between St. Louis and San Francisco beginning Feb. 11, 2010.

The westbound flight will depart Lambert-St. Louis International Airport at 6:30 p.m., arriving at San Francisco International Airport at 7:41 p.m. Eastbound service will depart San Francisco at 12:05 p.m. and arrive in St. Louis at 5:50 p.m.

At San Francisco International – where United operates more than 230 daily departures – customers traveling to and from St. Louis will have convenient access to and from points in the western U.S. and Canada and Australia.

“We are delighted to provide travelers in St. Louis with new, convenient nonstop service to San Francisco and to our extensive network throughout the west and to Australia,” says Greg Kaldahl, vice president of resource planning.

United will operate the service using an Airbus A319 aircraft, with eight seats in United First, 40 seats in United Economy Plus and 72 seats in United Economy.
