AirTran adding flights at Lambert with service to Milwaukee

Two years after inaugurating service at Lambert, AirTran Airways is expanding operations with the addition of two daily non-stop flights to Milwaukee's General Mitchell International Airport. Service will begin May 21.

The new service to Milwaukee will also give St. Louis area passengers connections to another 15 AirTran Airways destinations including Seattle, San Francisco, San Diego, Minneapolis and Boston. AirTran currently operates three daily flights from Lambert's Concourse B to Atlanta and Orlando.

"Our passengers have really embraced AirTran Airways in the last two years because of its service and fares," said Lambert Director Richard Hrabko. "We're excited that AirTran is now building on that success and expanding operations to give the St. Louis area even more travel options."

AirTran Airways has released introductory fares as low as \$59 one-way to Milwaukee on flights booked before March 23, 2009.

Lambert is the 30th busiest airport in the U.S. as ranked by Airports Council International-North America. Lambert serves nearly 15 million passengers a year with an average of 300 daily departures to 72 national and international destinations.
