Delta adds non-stops from Lambert to Raleigh-Durham

(St. Louis) Delta is adding more flights out of Lambert with new nonstops to Raleigh-Durham, NC. The twice daily roundtrip service will begin November 1, 2010. The new flights are part of Delta's on-going strategy to connect top business markets.

Raleigh-Durham is the third market added to St. Louis in recent months. Delta will begin four daily flights to New York-LaGuardia on September 7, 2010. The following month, October 31, Delta will also begin flying four daily flights to Washington Reagan National.

By November, Delta will operate 41 peak-day flights from Lambert to 10 destinations, with nonstop service to Atlanta; Cincinnati; Washington, D.C.; Detroit; New York-LaGuardia; New York-JFK; Memphis; Minneapolis-St. Paul; Raleigh-Durham and Salt Lake City.

Lambert is the 33rd busiest airport in North America as ranked by Airports Council International-North America. Lambert served more than 12.5 million passengers in 2009. Lambert-St. Louis International Airport is an Enterprise Fund Department of the City of St. Louis. It is wholly supported by airport user charges. No general fund revenues are used for the operation, administration, promotion or maintenance of airport facilities.
