The Greater St. Louis Chapter of the Honor Flight Network sponsored the veterans' trip to Washington, DC. Volunteer escorts, called Guardians, accompanied the veterans on the trip to see the National WWII Memorial and other major landmarks. Honor Flight offers free trips to senior veterans who would likely never be able to make the trip on their own. Several other Honor Flight trips have launched from Lambert this year.
