“Paint Job”

The Lambert airfield crew took advantage of a perfect, fall day this week to re-stripe the centerline of runway 12R-30L. The centerline identifies the center of the runway and gives pilots guidance during takeoff and landings. The centerline consists of a series of 3 ft x 120 ft stripes that run down the entire length of the 11,000 ft runway. The paint job consumed 210 gallons of paint. This paint job is expected to withstand the wear and tear of take-offs and landings, and the weather, for three to five years.
