A soldier who vanished in Korea nearly 60 years ago was returned to his home state of Missouri August 5. The family of Sgt. Charles Wilson gathered at Lambert for the anticipated arrival of the former “Missing in Action” soldier from Ava, Mo. The family was supported by members of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, Douglas County Sheriff’s Department, Lambert Airport Police, St. Louis Firefighters, the American Red Cross and members of the Patriot Guard. Police and Patriot Guard riders provided an escort for the soldier to Southern Missouri where Sgt. Wilson is to be buried with full military honors.
