It's been one dreary week across St. Louis which has been socked in with several straight days of fog. During these conditions, floating lights on the horizon is the only visual clue that a plane is about to pierce through the dense blanket of mist to land. Fog can present difficult conditions to operate, but Lambert, Air Traffic Control and all of its airlines work together during low visibility conditions. This effort includes directing planes to follow specific airfield routes to maximize safety and keep all flight operations on track.
