“Roof Renovations”

Imagine how much room there is to roam at Lambert. Now imagine how much it takes to cover all that space. The airport roofing systems are quite expansive and when it comes time to repair or renew, it's a massive job. That's what's happening now with roof renovations for the A, B and C Concourses. In all, workers are laying down 170,000 sq. feet of new roofing material that will perform better, especially when it comes to maintenance and troubleshooting. Furthermore, workers are adding new layers of roof insulation below the new rubber membrane for improved efficiency ratings. The old roof materials—gravel and rubber—are being recycled.
