“Storm Front”



Lambert's Terminal 1 reflects the storm front as it passes over the Airport on June 2.

We all wish for perfect blue skies, but sometimes we need a little turbulence to magnify the scene. A June 2 morning storm offered amazing visuals as it hovered over the arched domes of Terminal 1. Notice the storm clouds in the windows. These are actually reflections of the same storm to the west of the terminal. And yet, as you look down the arched roof tops, you can see the leading edge of the storm clouds as it breaks into the bright sky. Within minutes after the dark skies and heavier winds enveloped the airfield, the control tower had to switch the direction of takeoffs and landings. It would be another 40 minutes before rain would follow in a brief, but hard downpour. And then, all clear.
