“Triple Digits”

For the second week in a row, St. Louis was stuck in a dangerous heat wave. The forecast was punctuated by high temperatures hitting triple digits. Throw in the heat index—add 5 to 10 degrees. Crews were strategically scheduled to work as early as possible and call it a day when temps really blistered the Airport, anytime after 3 p.m. Even a few thunderstorms this week did little to cool us off.
