# QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

#### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

- Q1. Can a Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV) be used as a Vehicle?
- A1. Yes, so long as the SUV has the capacity to carry a minimum of seven (7) passengers in addition to a driver and reasonable space for luggage. See the definition of "Vehicle or vehicle" in the Sample Agreement, as amended by the First Addendum to this SFB.
- Q2. The First Addendum noted that Terminal 1 passengers will load on the Brown Level of the Airport garage; would the Airport consider relocating this pick up spot back to the covered Yellow Level (see Exhibit A)?
- A2. No, not at this time.
- Q3. What State of Missouri authority is required to operate this concession?
- A3. It is the responsibility of the Concessionaire to determine and demonstrate that it holds appropriate licenses from competent authorities to conduct its operation. See Section 301 of the Sample Agreement ("Rights")
- Q4. May Vehicles be left unattended on airport drives?
- A4. No. When on airport drives, the vehicles must be attended at all times.
