**STL Area:** The Airport is comprised of 3,675 acres. Of that, 1,888, acres are located

inside the Airport Operations Area fence.

STL Terminals: STL has 1,419,597 square feet of terminal space encompassing two

terminal buildings with 85 boarding gates at full capacity. Three gates in

Terminal 2 can be used for international arrivals.

Cargo @ STL: STL has 118,000 square feet of dedicated cargo space and 130,825

square feet of multi-purpose space (Cargo City) that is used for cargo, equipment maintenance, airline provisioning, etc., by a variety of
