This Agreement, made and entered into this day of, 2014 (the
"Agreement"), by and between the City of St. Louis, a municipal corporation of the State of
Missouri (the "City" or "borrower") and Missouri History Museum.
WITNESSETH THAT:
WHEREAS, City owns and operates Lambert-St. Louis International Airport (the
"Airport"); and
WHEREAS, City seeks to contract with the Contractor for certain services described
herein.
NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the payments, terms, conditions,

agreements, hereinafter set forth, to be made and performed by City, the Contractor hereby promises and agrees that it will faithfully perform all the services called for by this Agreement, in the manner and under the terms, covenants, and conditions hereinafter set forth.

Note: The term of this Agreement shall be three (3) years, beginning on January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2017.

CONDITIONS GOVERNING LOANS

I. CARE AND SECURITY

- A. The building in which the items on loan are to be exhibited must be of fire resistant construction and must be provided with protective devices against fire, theft and damage. Objects on loan must be protected from extreme temperatures and humidity, excessive light and from insects, vermin, dirt or other environmental hazards.
- B. The building must have either 24-hour guard service or dependable automatic instruction alarm devices. During the hours the objects are on exhibit a guard or guards must be on duty.
- C. The items on loan may be handled only by professional members of the staff of the borrowing institution.
- D. The items on loan must be exhibited in such a way that they are protected from handling by visitors. Except for those items that may be separately mounted or hung on walls, all objects must be exhibited in locked cases. Such cases must be so constructed as to excluded dust, dirt and excessive heat.
- E. No material may be cleaned, repaired, retouched or altered in any way without express permission from the Missouri Historical Society. No adhesives, pins, nails or other fastening devices for installation purposes shall be used in any way that might damage the objects. The borrower agrees to meet any special requirements for installation and handling as noted on the face of this loan agreement form.
- F. Damages, whether in transit or on the borrower's premises, must be reported to the Missouri Historical Society.

II. TRANSPORTATION AND INSURANCE

- A. The borrower is responsible for costs of packing, transporting and insuring the objects on loan, unless otherwise noted. Material included in the loan shall be packed for shipment by an experienced and competent packer; and shall be placed in lender's crate for return to the Missouri Historical Society, unless otherwise mutually agreed upon by the lender and the borrower.
- B. Unless the borrower indicated that the Missouri Historical Society is to insure the items on loan and bill for the cost, the borrower agrees to cover the objects on loan with an all-risk insurance policy from the time they leave the Missouri Historical Society until the time they are returned. Evidence of this coverage may be requested by the Missouri Historical Society before the objects leave its premises.

III. REPRODUCTION

- A. Photographs may be taken for exhibition record only. If the object is framed or in a case it should not be removed. Photographs of the object for publicity or exhibition catalog should be ordered from the Missouri History Museum prior to the starting date of the loan.
- B. Objects may not be reproduced in any media, including photographs, for purposes of sale.

IV. CREDIT

- A. Wherever the items are on view, the following credit line must also be prominently displayed: Courtesy of the Missouri History Museum, St. Louis.
- B. All photographs taken for record and for publicity or exhibition shall carry the aforementioned credit line to protect copyright.
