

Lambert Art & Culture Program Call for Exhibitors

Q&A

Q1: I wanted to know would it be possible to display a single-channel video on a wall mounted screen with some yarn on the floor (of the window display)? Can the airport provide a video monitor/ screen?

A1: We don't have a monitor or screen that we can provide. However, if you'd like to include that as part of your presentation, you'd be responsible for the monitor, mount and other materials necessary for the installation.

Q2: Is it possible to submit several proposals for the 2D walls?

A2: If you have more than one body or work or collection that you would like to propose, please submit each as a separate application. You may submit up to three applications.

Q3: Do you have size specifications of the walls (running horizontal feet)?

A3: The wall sizes will be provided to artists once they are selected for a specific wall. The lengths range from 12' 10" to 56'. Q4: Does everything need to be framed in the Kling Family East Gallery?

A4: All artwork needs to be ready to hang. We do not do any framing. However, if you need assistance with framing, we can work with you to find resources. Work such as textiles do not need to be framed but should have connection points to allow for the work to be safely and securely attached to the wall.

Q5: How large is the T2 Wall?

A5: Approximately 56' long.

Q6: Can you exhibit more than one artist in the Kling Family East Gallery?

A6: If you are a curator or organization, you may propose more than one artist for any of the sites. If you are an artist and would like to apply as a team with other artists, you may do that as well.

Q7: For the moving walkway space, how many bays do you give each exhibitor?

A7: Typically, 2 or 3, but we have also done 1.

Q8: Could an artist or exhibitor exhibit in more than one location.

A8: Typically, we try to have one exhibitor per location, but we have made special exceptions.

Q9: If I have previously exhibited, can I still apply.

A9: Yes.

Q10: Do you have data on the number of people viewing the exhibitions?

A10: We do not have specific viewer data. However, 7 million people pass through each terminal annually. That does not include “meter-greeters” or the approximately 5,000 airport employees.

Q11. Do you have openings for the exhibitions?

Q11. We do not host openings. If you would like to bring a group to see the work, or host your own event, we can work with you. There are some limitations with sites that are post-security.
