STL Area: The Airport is comprised of 3,675 acres. Of that, 1,888, acres are located inside the Airport Operations Area fence.

STL Terminals: STL has 1,419,597 square feet of terminal space encompassing two terminal buildings.

Cargo @ STL: STL has 135,000 square feet of dedicated cargo space and 130,825 square feet of multi-purpose space (Cargo City) that is used for cargo, equipment maintenance, airline provisioning, etc., by a variety of tenants.

Capital Improvement Program:

STL has undergone nearly \$600 million in capital improvements since 2010

Major Construction Projects:

In 2025, STL will design and construct a new central utility plant, relocate the airfield maintenance campus, design and construct a new West deicing pad and demolish the vacant Air National Guard complex. The cost is estimated at approximately \$345 million**.
