- Q1. General Contract Terms. Payment Bond (p. 10). Will the City clarify if a payment bond is required for this RFP? Traditionally, payment bonds apply to general construction companies and do not apply to EMS.
- A1. Both a Payment Bond and a Performance Bond are required for this service
- Q2. General Contract Terms. Bonding Documentation (p. 14). The requirement references “A form acceptable to the City is attached.” But no form is included in the Attachments section of the RFP. Will the City please include the acceptable template?
